

Dear Class Family,

I have great news to share with you. I wrote to H.G. Bishop Youssef, Southern USA Diocese, telling him about our curriculum in the class, which includes evangelism lessons, Bible study, spiritual life, theology, the fathers of the Church, and the liturgical life. I told him about my desire to make this class as a standard that is recognized by the bishopric. I told him that we will have a final exam in addition to the assignments. Moreover, I informed him of the class graduation requirements; one of which is to participate in an evangelistic or missionary work. Upon completion of the class requirements, the graduates will get a certificate signed by H.G. Bishop Youssef.

The great news is His Grace's acceptance and approval of the certificate plan.

Now here are the details:

Grading and Graduations requirements for the Evangelism Class:

1. Every lesson has questions, each of which is worth 5 points.
2. There 20 points for every day spent on missions.
3. The final exam is worth 50 points. It is a take-home exam.
4. To graduate from the class, you need to participate in at least one mission; you don't need to go overseas. We can work with you to arrange for a local mission.
5. Since Christ determines that the fruits of the Kingdom of God are 30%, 60%, and 100%, we will follow the same grading scale. Here is the grading scale:
 - 30%- 59%: grade "C"
 - 60% - 90%: grade "B"
 - over 91%: grade "A"

The certificate will include the details of the curriculum of the Evangelism Class and will be signed by H.G. Bishop Yuossef, Bishop of the Southern USA.

The above grading and graduation rules will be applied in this class. Therefore, it is your responsibility to go back and answer all previous lessons' questions and send them to the teacher. Brother Antonios and I will start grading the previous lessons. Please pray for the class. Thanks.
